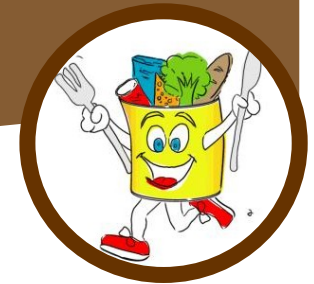

Things to Know

Packet pick up will be provided at Forest Park Shelter 5 starting at 6:45 a.m. race day morning. Please note that friends and/or family may pick up your packet. If a friend or family member is to pick up your packet, please have him/her bring a copy of your confirmation receipt OR a copy of your driver's license for verification (*picture on mobile device is acceptable*). There will be no bag check on site.

Public parking is available on a limited basis at Forest Park. Parking is also available in downtown Noblesville.

Before the start of the race there will be raffle prizes drawn. Every race participant will receive a raffle entry with his/her bib number. So, arrive early! If you bring in five or more non-perishable food items, you get

an extra entry. Let's haul in those cans! Prizes will be held for pick up until winners are finished. Post race music and goodies will also be available. Tables will be set up in Forest Park for first aid, post-race refreshments, and local vendor offerings. Water, lavatories, and race route markets will be available along the course. View the course map for specific table locations.

Strollers - Yes! Pets - Yes! Earbuds—Yes!

The 5K Run & 1.5mi Family Walk begins at 8:30 a.m. in Forest Park. The courses are timed for accuracy. And, the finish line officially closes at 12:00 p.m. (3.5 hours).

Any runner or walker who is felt to be posing a safety concern to other participants, or himself, may be removed from the race at the discretion of the Race Directors.
